Go to first stop sign (approx .8 miles, Monmouth Fire Dept North Station). Turn right onto Pisgah Rd. Approx 1.6 miles to trailhead parking lot on right (Tower Rd).	Mt. Pisgah: the parking lot and a kiosk on the Mt. Pisgah Road are the trailhead for the blue blazed Tower Trail. This is a 1 mile easy/moderate	The 730-acre large undeveloped area of forests and wetlands, streams and ponds, mountain tops and ridges that provides a variety of outdoor recreational activities. The trail climbs to the 60-foot Mt. Pisgah fire tower which is open to the public. On a clear day, the views from the top of the tower are outstanding.
